Directions to Cook Park

From Durham Road go South on SW 92nd Ave into Cook Park (92nd Ave. runs along the west side of Tigard H.S.)

Proceed straight ahead through the main gates. Keep going until you must turn left or right and go right. Keep following that road until you reach (Shelter 3.) (Shelter 3 is by the Tualatin River boat ramp.)

To help with parking, carpool with other church members, come a little bit early, drop off your passengers, lawn chairs and food for the potluck then park your car in one of the main parking areas nearer to the main gate. It is a short and enjoyable walk.

The Cal-van will bring you from the usual stops. If you would like to ride the Cal-van from church, be at Calvin no later than 9:30 am.
